## FROM THE COUNCIL

The consistory approved the 2025-2026 catechism season beginning on August 27 for the Wednesday evening classes and on Tuesday, September 2 for the Bible History Classes. The schedule will be: Heidelberg Catechism (8th and 9th grades) at 7:00 and Essentials (10th and 11th grades) at 8:00 on Wednesday evenings. All classes begin with the first lessons. The Juniors use the written-out memory verses in the books. The Seniors do not need to do memory verses. The Creeds class (12th grade) will be held alternative Sunday mornings after the worship service.
