At the congregational meeting this past week, Mr. Lane Brummel, Mr. Brad De Boer, and Mr. Vern Hoekstra were voted into the office of elder, and Mr. Darrin Brummel and Mr. Brad Potjer were voted into the office of deacon. Providing there are no objections, these men will be installed into their respective offices on January 4, 2026. The General Fund budget of \$58 per week per family and the Building Fund budget of \$25 per family per month were also approved with the understanding that single members would contribute 1/3 that amount. The proposed parking addition of 29 spaces on the east side of church with access to 3rd street was approved as presented.
