## FROM THE COUNCIL

We welcome Rev. Kleyn into our fellowship again this Sunday. We are grateful for presence and for his leading us in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. We pray for God's blessing as we partake of the sacrament together

After a week of self-examination, confessing members in good standing are called and privileged to partake of the sacrament of the Lord's Supper this morning. Our participation in the Lord's Supper is a witness that we repent of our sins, believe that Jesus Christ is our righteousness, and desire to live in godliness. As this heavenly food can be taken to one's judgment (I Cor. 11:28-30) and as the receiving of this food as a congregational body is a confession of doctrinal oneness (Acts 2:42), the elders supervise the partaking of the sacrament. If you are visiting from another PRC congregation, please contact the elders before communing. Visitors from other denominations must appear to make their request at the consistory meeting prior to communion. If we cannot administer the sacrament to you, we are not judging whether or not you are a child of God; we are simply recognizing the reality that there is not at this time doctrinal agreement between our respective church bodies. Please respect our desire to be faithful to God's Word in this matter.

Next Sunday morning we will have an elderly-led video service for our morning worship, and Rev. Kleyn will lead us in a **2:00 PM afternoon** service.
