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FROM THE COUNCIL

We welcome Rev Smit to our pulpit today as he leads us in worship and in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. May our faith be strengthened through the preaching of God's Word and the use of the sacrament.

After a week of self-examination, confessing members in good standing are called and privileged to partake of the sacrament of the Lord’s Supper this morning. Our participation in the Lord’s Supper is a witness that we repent of our sins, believe that Jesus Christ is our righteousness, and desire to live in godliness. As this heavenly food can be taken to one’s judgment (I Cor. 11:28-30) and as the receiving of this food as a congregational body is a confession of doctrinal oneness (Acts 2:42), the elders supervise the partaking of the sacrament. If you are visiting from another PRC congregation, please contact the elders before communing. Visitors from other denominations must appear to make their request at the consistory meeting prior to communion. If we cannot administer the sacrament to you, we are not judging whether or not you are a child of God; we are simply recognizing the reality that there is not at this time doctrinal agreement between our respective church bodies. Please respect our desire to be faithful to God’s Word in this matter.

Next Sunday we will have a video service in the morning, and Rev. Regnerus will lead us in worship at 2 PM. Prof Griess will be in Calvary on Sunday, August 2.
